Black Non-Marking Sole Plimsoll
School Pumps

We are aware that some parents have concerns over their children having bare feet during PE sessions in the hall. We have consulted PE documentation and have decided to adapt our own policy to say that when pupils have PE lessons indoors, they should now wear plimsolls – strictly not trainers. There may be rare occasions during lessons, for example when using specific apparatus that children will have to remove their plimsolls for safety/slipping reasons. Then put them back on after the exercise has been completed.

Plimsolls can be bought from ASDA George for approximately £2.50.

Rainbows

At St. Theresa's, we run a group called 'Rainbows'. It is primarily aimed at children who have suffered loss, through the death of a family member or friend or pet animal. It is also for children whose parents are going through a family breakdown, or a parent being temporary away from home. The children who take part have around forty minutes in school time to work through issues that may be affecting them. It is a time (if they wish) to discuss and share things that they may otherwise find hard, and it gives them some time to explore their emotions in a confidential and quiet environment. The group is run by Mrs. Windle, our Learning Mentor. If you would like your child to take part in our Rainbows group, please see Mrs. Windle.
