

CHARGING AND REMISSIONS POLICY

The Governing Body of St. Theresa's Catholic Primary School reserves the right to make a charge for the following activities organised by the school:

The board and lodging element of the following residential activity which is deemed to take place within school hours, and outside school hours:

Hollowford Activity Centre

A contribution towards the cost of transport and admissions on the following activities organised by school:

Field Trips
Puppet Shows
Pantomimes
Football Outings

A contribution towards the cost of materials, equipment of ingredients for the following subjects:

Home Economics
Design Technology

- provided that the parents have indicated in advance that they wish to be the owners of the finished product.

The Governing Body may, from time to time, amend the categories of activity for which charges can be made.

Nothing in this policy statement precludes the Governing Body from inviting parents to make a voluntary contribution towards the cost of providing education for pupils.

In cases of family hardship which would make it difficult for pupils to take part in any activity for which a charge is made, parents are invited to apply, in confidence, to the Governing Body for the remission of charges in full or in part. Authorisation for remission will be made by the Headteacher in consultation with the Chair of Governors.
